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TRAVEL TO RLUS COURSES OUTSIDE MOSCOW AND ST PETERSBURG

YAROSLAVL

Long distance trains leave from Ярославский вокзал, which is on Комсомольская площадь (metro Комсомольская). There are normally two trains a day that finish at Yaroslavl and numerous other ones that stop at Yaroslavl and go on to Siberia.

TVER

Trains leave from Ленинградский вокзал, which is also on Комсомольская площадь (metro Комсомольская). You have a choice of local trains or fast trains to St Petersburg, etc, whose first stop is at Tver (Сапсан). You can book this train in advance, but they are more expensive.

The local trains are much cheaper. There are two types. The faster one costs more and takes about 1 hour 45 minutes. This train Russians call Ласточка. The slower local train takes an hour longer. You can't book these trains in advance. The ticket office and ticket machines are on the edge of the neighbouring Ярославский вокзал on the side next to Ленинградский вокзал.

PETROZAVODSK

Trains leave from Ладужский вокзал (metro Ладужская) in St Petersburg. There is a daily overnight sleeper, leaving at about 10pm and daytime trains, called Ласточка.

If you fly into Moscow, you can take a flight on to Petrozavodsk.

KAZAN

There are overnight trains from Казанский вокзал on Комсомольская площадь or regular flights from all the main Moscow airports.
